## How Do They Affect Me?

Pennsylvania Governor

Approves or vetoes laws passed by the state legislature which is part of the checks and balances of government.

Proposes a state budget which reflects his priorities for the economy and education.

Pennsylvania Lieutenant Governor

Becomes Governor in the event that the Governor dies or is unable to continue his duties.

Presides over the State Senate and supports the Governor's policies.

U.S. Senator  
U.S. Representative

Passes laws that affect the economic status of citizens such as minimum wage and equal pay for equal work.

Passes laws and budgets that affect security, health, and available governments services.

State Senator  
State Representative

Passes laws that affect air and water quality, adequate roads and bridges, and the rights of citizens.

Passes state budget that affects local and school taxes and community services.
