



### **AAUW-PA Student Advisory Council**

#### **Position Description**

From October through May, the members of the AAUW-PA Student Advisory Council (SAC) serve as AAUW ambassadors, and lead gender equality projects on their campuses. The SAC also advises the AAUW-PA board on the needs of college students.

AAUW-PA Board has one state meeting per year format. In this model AAUW-PA Conventions would occur in April in even-numbered years. In even-number years the SAC members will plan and deliver appropriate sections of AAUW-PA's Annual State Meeting in April. SAC members attend as guests of the state. In April in the odd-number years the SAC will attend the AAUW-PA State board meeting. In order to create leadership skills for the entire SAC during the odd years the April AAUW-PA board meeting will also serve as a platform for the SAC members to present to the board, attend the board meeting and have some programming specific to the SAC.

#### **Membership and Term of Office**

At least one member from each of the three state districts (East, West, Central), plus two more for a total of five (5) will serve for one academic year, approximately October to May. At the end of the term, SAC members will be expected to provide a short narrative report on the successes and challenges of their experience on the SAC.

#### **Student Requirements**

Students must be undergraduates in any year (freshman through senior) enrolled full-time in either a two- or four-year accredited College/University AAUW Partner member school in Pennsylvania. Both AAUW e-Student Members and members of AAUW Student Organizations are eligible. Members of AAUW Student Organizations will be given preference.

#### **AAUW-PA SAC Committee**

A committee of branch members from across the state chaired by the AAUW-PA C/U Liaison will help coordinate the activities of the SAC members and mentor these SAC members.

#### **What are the specific responsibilities of SAC members?**

- **Checking email regularly;** email is the primary communication vehicle for the SAC and SAC committee
- Participation in up to three conference call meetings throughout the year
- Attending the AAUW-PA State Annual Meeting and Convention in even-numbered years or the AAUW-PA State Board meeting in odd-numbered years. In-person meetings, which also occur will have expenses paid by the state
- As a group and in cooperation with the state SAC committee, planning and implementing a project, presentation, and/or panel for the State Annual Meeting and Convention or the AAUW-PA State Board Meeting depending on your term year
- Promoting the free e-Student Membership program for undergraduates and partner member schools
- Developing student level, student-led initiative(s), possibly including promoting participation in NCCWSL
- Fostering collaboration between C/U partner members and local branches on AAUW issues

- Developing and honing your leadership skills and becoming an agent for positive change
- Networking with amazing student leaders and distinguished professional women statewide
- Adding an impressive credential to your resume or curriculum vitae
